22 Section 15. The amount of \$114,000, or so much thereof 23 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois 24 Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the 25 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission for printing and 26 distribution of Workers' Compensation handbooks containing 27 information as to the rights and obligations of employers.

implementation and operation of an accident reporting system.

2 Section 25. The sum of \$113,200, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers' 4 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Illinois 5 Workers' Compensation Commission for all costs associated 6 with the establishment and operation of a satellite office in 7 the Metro East area.

9 Section 30. The sum of \$3,800,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers' 11 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Illinois 12 Workers' Compensation Commission for costs associated with 13 the establishment, administration and operations of the 14 workers' compensation anti-fraud program administered by the 15 Illinois State Police.
