

## 94TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2005 and 2006 SB1679

Introduced 2/24/2005, by Sen. Mattie Hunter

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Mercury-Free Vaccine Act. Provides that a person who is knowingly pregnant or who is under 3 years of age shall not be vaccinated with a mercury-containing vaccine or injected with a mercury-containing product that contains more than 0.5 micrograms of mercury per 0.5 milliliter dose. Provides that a person who is knowingly pregnant or who is under 3 years of age shall not be vaccinated with a mercury-containing influenza vaccine that contains more than 1.0 micrograms of mercury per 0.5 milliliter dose. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Mercury-Free Vaccine Act.
- 6 Section 5. Banned mercury-containing vaccines.
- 7 (a) Except for an influenza vaccine described in subsection
- 8 (b), a person who is knowingly pregnant or who is under 3 years
- 9 of age shall not be vaccinated with a mercury-containing
- 10 vaccine or injected with a mercury-containing product that
- 11 contains more than 0.5 micrograms of mercury per 0.5 milliliter
- dose.
- 13 (b) A person who is knowingly pregnant or who is under 3
- 14 years of age shall not be vaccinated with a mercury-containing
- influenza vaccine that contains more than 1.0 micrograms of
- mercury per 0.5 milliliter dose.
- 17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 18 becoming law.
