

## 94TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2005 and 2006 SB1960

Introduced 2/25/2005, by Sen. Jeffrey M. Schoenberg

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/12-21.7 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Prohibits the sale of yo-yo waterballs in the State. Provides that a violation is a business offense punishable by a \$1,001 fine for each violation. Provides that each sale of a yo-yo waterball is a separate offense.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding Section 12-21.7 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/12-21.7 new)
- 7 Sec. 12-21.7. Sale of yo-yo waterballs prohibited.
- 8 (a) It is unlawful to sell a yo-yo waterball in this State.
- 9 (b) Sentence. A person who sells a yo-yo waterball in this
- 10 State is guilty of a business offense punishable by a fine of
- 11 \$1,001 for each violation. Each sale of a yo-yo waterball in
- violation of this Section is a separate violation.
- (c) Definition. In this Section, "yo-yo waterball" means a
- 14 <u>water yo-yo or a soft, rubber-like ball that is filled with a</u>
- 15 <u>liquid and is attached to an elastic cord.</u>
