1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

7 Section 5. "AN ACT concerning appropriations", Public  
8 Act 094-015, approved June 10, 2005, is amended by adding new  
9 Sections 31, 32, 95A and 95B to Article 119, as follows:

12 Sec. 31. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the School  
14 Construction Fund to the Capital Development Board for school  
15 construction grants pursuant to the School Construction Law  
16 for the projects hereinafter enumerated:

17 STATEWIDE

18 For School Construction Grants .....149,000,000

21 Sec. 32. The following named amount, or so much thereof  
22 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the School  
23 Construction Fund to the State Board of Education for School  
24 Construction Maintenance Grants for the projects hereinafter  
25 enumerated:

27 For School Maintenance Grants .....\$50,000,000

30 Sec. 95A. The sum of \$250,000,000, or so much thereof as  
31 may be necessary, for statewide use pursuant to Section  
32 4(a)(1) of the General Obligation Bond Act, is appropriated

1 from the Transportation Bond Series A Fund to the Department  
2 of Transportation for land acquisition, engineering  
3 (including environmental studies and archaeological  
4 activities and other studies and activities necessary or  
5 appropriate to secure federal participation in the project),  
6 and construction, including reconstruction, extension and  
7 improvement of State highways, arterial highways, roads,  
8 structures separating highways and railroads and bridges and  
9 for purposes allowed or required by Title 23 of the U.S. Code  
10 as provided by law in order to implement a portion of the  
11 Fiscal Year 2006 road improvements program.

14 Sec. 95B. The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation  
16 Bond Series B Fund to the Department of Transportation for  
17 construction costs, making grants and providing project  
18 assistance to municipalities, special transportation  
19 districts, private non-profit carriers, mass transportation  
20 carriers and the Intercity rail program for the acquisition,  
21 construction, extension, reconstruction, and improvement of  
22 mass transportation facilities, including rapid transit,  
23 intercity rail, bus and other equipment used in connection  
24 therewith, as provided by law, pursuant to Section 4 (b)(1)  
25 of the General Obligation Bond Act, as amended.

26 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect  
27 immediately.
