WHEREAS, He was called to preach in 1958 when he was a senior in high school; he began his pastoral ministry two years later and received degrees from Ouachita Baptist University, Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, and Luther Rice Seminary; he was the pastor in churches in Tennessee, Indiana, Texas, and Illinois, including the First Baptist Church in DuQuoin; and

WHEREAS, He and his wife, along with Les and Sandy Snyder of West Frankfort, founded Community of Faith Church in November 1979; he also served as Director of the Department of Evangelism for the Illinois Baptist State Association; he preached in many revivals across the country and spent 36 years in pastoral ministry; and

WHEREAS, He was preceded in death by his parents; and
