SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the State of Illinois 3 learned with sadness of the death of Mark A. Linder, age 31, of 4 Peoria, on October 15, 2005; and

5 WHEREAS, He was born October 18, 1973 in Peoria to Jody 6 Linder and Rex Linder; and

7 WHEREAS, Mark was graduated from Richwoods High School; he 8 received his bachelor's degree from Southern Illinois 9 University in 1995; he completed his master's degree studies at 10 Western Kentucky University in 1997 in the field of 11 industrial-occupational psychology; and

12 WHEREAS, He was employed in Information Services at CEFCU13 (Citizens Equity First Credit Union); and

14 WHEREAS, He was an active volunteer with the American Red 15 Cross and the Relay for Life; he was active in the American 16 Brain Tumor Association and that Association honored Mark by 17 establishing an academic fellowship in his honor, known as the 18 Mark Linder/American Brain Tumor Association Fellowship; and

WHEREAS, Mark founded the Walk for the Mind, a fundraiser walk for brain tumor research, which was first held on Peoria's Riverfront in 2003; the most recent Walk for the Mind in 2005 involved more than 300 participants and raised in excess of \$25,000 for brain tumor research and related activities; and
