SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/12-614 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a person may not operate or permit to be operated on any highway of this State a vehicle with a trailer hitch that extends more than 4 inches beyond the rear of the vehicle, unless that vehicle is towing another vehicle.

- Sec. 12-614. Trailer hitch; length limit when not in use. A
- 8 person may not operate or permit to be operated on any highway
- 9 of this State a vehicle with a trailer hitch that extends more
- 10 than 4 inches beyond the rear of the vehicle, unless that
- 11 <u>vehicle is towing another vehicle.</u>
