### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Force-Fed Birds Act. Prohibits force-feeding birds and the selling, serving, or dispensing of products that are the result of force-feeding birds. Provides that violation of the Act is a petty offense with a fine of \$1,000.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
Force-Fed Birds Act.

6 Section 5. Prohibition; penalties.

7 (a) In this Section:

8 (1) A "bird" includes, but is not limited to, a duck
9 or goose.

10 (2) "Force-feeding a bird" means a process that causes 11 the bird to consume more food than a typical bird of the 12 same species would consume voluntarily. Force-feeding 13 methods include, but are not limited to, delivering feed 14 through a tube or other device inserted into the bird's 15 esophagus.

(b) A person may not force-feed a bird for the purpose of enlarging the bird's liver beyond normal size or hire another person to do so.

(c) A product may not be sold, served, or dispensed in this
State if it is the result of force-feeding a bird for the
purpose of enlarging the bird's liver beyond normal size.

(d) A person who knowingly violates this Section is guiltyof a petty offense and shall be fined \$1,000. Each day that a
