SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-664 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the issuance of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome license plates. Provides that in addition to the appropriate registration fees, an applicant for the special plate shall be charged an original issuance fee of \$45 and a fee of \$32 for each renewal. Provides that the additional original issuance fee and the renewal fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

AN ACT concerning transportation. 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding 5 Section 3-664 as follows:
- (625 ILCS 5/3-664 new) 6
- 7 Sec. 3-664. Sudden Infant Death Syndrome license plates.
- (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made in 8 9 the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special 10 registration plates designated as Sudden Infant Death Syndrome license plates. The special plates issued under this Section 11 shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first 12 division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not 13
- 14 more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure established by
- 16 Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

- 17 (b) The design and color of the plates is wholly within the
- discretion of the Secretary. The Secretary may allow the plates 18
- 19 to be issued as vanity or personalized plates under Section
- 3-405.1 of the Code. The Secretary shall prescribe stickers or 20
- 21 decals as provided under Section 3-412 of this Code.
- 22 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a
- \$45 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate 2.3

- 1 <u>registration fee. This fee shall be deposited into the</u>
- 2 <u>Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be used by</u>
- 3 the Secretary to help defray the administrative processing
- 4 costs.
- 5 For each registration renewal period, a \$32 fee, in
- 6 <u>addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged.</u>
- 7 This fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special
- 8 <u>License Plate Fund.</u>
