Amends the Military Code of Illinois and the Department of Veterans Affairs Act. Provides that no employee of the Department of Military Affairs or the Department of Veterans Affairs may remove sensitive material, including without limitation material containing social security numbers of or other personal information concerning veterans or their families, from Department offices without authorization. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Military Code of Illinois is amended by 5 adding Section 31 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 1805/31 new)

Sec. 31. Removal of sensitive material. No employee of the Department of Military Affairs may remove electronic or paper copies of sensitive material, including without limitation material containing social security numbers of or other personal information concerning veterans or their families, from Department offices without the express authorization of the Adjutant General.

Section 10. The Department of Veterans Affairs Act is amended by adding Section 20 as follows:

17 <u>Sec. 20. Removal of sensitive material.
