The Developmental Disability and Mental 5 Disability Services Act is amended by changing Section 3-5 as 6 follows: 7 (405 ILCS 80/3-5) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 1803-5) Sec. 3-5. The Department shall create application forms 8 which shall be used to determine the eligibility of families 9 10 for the Program. The forms shall require at least the following 11 items of information which constitute the eligibility criteria 12 for participation in the Program: 13 (a) A statement that the family resides in the State of

(b) A statement that the family member is 17 years of age

- 1 (c) A statement that the family member resides, or is 2 expected to reside, with his or her parent or legal guardian, 3 or that the family member resides in an out-of-home placement
- 4 with the expectation of residing with the parent or legal
- 5 guardian within 2 months of the date of the application.
- 6 (d) Verification that the family member has one of the

following conditions: severe autism, severe mental illness,

- 8 severe or profound mental retardation, or severe and multiple
- 9 impairments. Verification of the family member's condition
- 10 shall be:

- 11 (1) by the family member's local school district for family
- members enrolled with a local school district; or
- 13 (2) by an entity designated by the Department.
- 14 (e) Verification that the taxable income for the family for
- 15 the year immediately preceding the date of the application did
- 16 not exceed an amount to be established by rule of the
- 17 Department, unless it can be verified that the taxable income
- 18 for the family for the year in which the application is made
- 19 will be less than such amount. The maximum taxable family
- 20 income set by rule of the Department may not be less than
- 21 \$65,000 beginning January 1, 2008.
