Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the Secretary of State shall not issue a series of special license plates, except as authorized under the Code.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 3-600 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-600) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-600)
- 7 Sec. 3-600. Requirements for issuance of special plates.
- 8 (a) The Secretary of State shall not issue a series of
 9 special plates unless applications, as prescribed by the
 10 Secretary, have been received for 10,000 plates of that series;
 11 except that the Secretary of State may prescribe some other
 12 required number of applications if that number is sufficient to
 13 pay for the total cost of designing, manufacturing and issuing
 14 the special license plate.
 - (a-5) The Secretary of State shall not issue a series of special license plates, except as provided in this Article VI or as otherwise provided in this Code.
 - (b) The Secretary of State, upon issuing a new series of special license plates, shall notify all law enforcement officials of the design, color and other special features of the special license plate series.
- (c) This Section shall not apply to special license plate categories in existence on the effective date of this

- discretion as established in Section 3-611.
