Appropriates \$10,000,000 to the Illinois Department of Human Services, Division of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse, to fund services for 2260 substance abusing offenders. Effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much of that  
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois  
6 Department of Human Services, Division of Alcoholism and  
7 Substance Abuse, to fund services for 2260 substance abusing  
8 offenders, including:

9 (1) abuse treatment provided by organizations  
10 licensed by the Department of Human Services to do  
11 so; and

12 (2) screening, assessment and case management  
13 performed by the program designated by the State  
14 under Section 40-5 of the Alcoholism and Other Drug  
15 Abuse and Dependency Act; and

16 (3) other recovery support services.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
18 2007.
