SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

750 ILCS 50/13.1

Amends the Adoption Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the order for standby adoption.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Adoption Act is amended by changing Section
- 5 13.1 as follows:
- 6 (750 ILCS 50/13.1)
- 7 Sec. 13.1. Order for standby adoption.
- 8 (a) If it is proved to the the satisfaction of the court,
- 9 after such investigation as the court deems necessary, that the
- 10 child's parent consents to or fails to object to the standby
- adoption and adoption by the petitioner will be for the welfare
- of the child, the court may enter an order for standby
- adoption. However, the consenting parent's parental rights may
- 14 not be terminated until consent becomes effective.
- 15 (b) The order for standby adoption shall be final as to all
- findings and shall be followed in the judgment of adoption
- 17 unless the court finds by clear and convincing evidence that it
- is no longer in the best interest of the child for the adoption
- 19 to be finalized.
- 20 (c) Once the standby adoptive parent receives knowledge of
- 21 the death of the consenting parent, or the consenting parent
- 22 requests that a final judgment for adoption be entered, the
- 23 standby adoptive parent shall have 60 days to apply for a

- 1 judgment for adoption.
