Amends the Governor Transition Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the orderly transition of the office of Governor.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Governor Transition Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (15 ILCS 10/1) (from Ch. 127, par. 63b121)
- 7 Sec. 1. When at any general election for the the office of Governor the incumbent Governor is not elected, the Governor, 8 9 within 2 weeks after such election, shall provide space for not 10 more than 5 persons designated by the Governor-elect to enable the Governor-elect to begin a review and analysis of budgeted 11 expenditures during the then current biennium and budget 12 requests for the ensuing biennium and to acquire a working 13 14 knowledge of the various offices, departments, commissions, boards and other agencies of the executive branch of the State 15 16 government. The Governor shall cooperate with 17 Governor-elect and the staff so designated by him and provide any assistance that may be reasonably requested. 18
