And in all 7 8 laws, statutes, orders, judgments, rules and regulations 9 relating to the time of performance of any act of any officer 10 or department of this state, or of any county, township, city 11 or town, municipal corporation, agency or instrumentality of the state, or school district or school authority or relating 12 13 to the time in which any rights shall accrue or determine, or within which any act shall or shall not be performed by any 14 15 person subject to the jurisdiction of the state, and in all the 16 public schools and in all institutions of the state, or of any county, township, city or town, municipal corporation, agency 17 or instrumentality of the state or school district or school 18 authority, and in all contracts or choses in action made or to 19 20 be performed in the state, it shall be understood and intended 21 that the time shall be the time prescribed in this section.
