SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 20/2.5 new

Amends the Gasoline Receptacle Labeling Act. Makes it unlawful for a minor under the age of 14 to dispense flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, from any portable container, whether plastic or metal, unless the minor is supervised by an adult. Requires a manufacturer to affix a permanent warning label on each portable container used for dispensing flammable or combustible liquids. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning public safety.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Gasoline Receptacle Labeling Act is amended
by adding Section 2.5 as follows:

7 Sec. 2.5. Dispensing of flammable or combustible liquids by minors. It is unlawful for a minor under the age of 14 to 8 9 dispense flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, 10 from any portable container, whether plastic or metal, unless the minor is supervised by an adult. Each manufacturer shall 11 12 affix a permanent warning label on each portable container used for dispensing flammable or combustible liquids that reads: 13 "MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF 14 SHALL NOT DISPENSE FLAMMABLE OR 14 COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS FROM PORTABLE CONTAINERS UNLESS SUPERVISED 15 16 BY AN ADULT." The letters shall be one-half inch in height and 17 shall have a color that is different from the color of the container and distinctive so the warning can be easily read by 18 19 the user.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 21 becoming law.
