appropriated for such purposes, the sum of \$50,000, or so much of this amount as may be necessary, and remains unexpended on June 30, 2007 from appropriations heretofore made for such purposes in Section 225 of Article 25 of Public Act 94-0798 is reappropriated from the Live and Learn Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for a grant to the Chicago Public Library, Brainerd Branch.

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9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 10 2007.
