SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-412

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-412

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that, beginning with the first general replacement of multi-year registration plates that occurs after the effective date of the amendatory Act, all registration plates shall be designed with a space for a sticker or device on the rear registration plate that specifies the name of the county of residence of the registrant, and that the sticker or device shall be issued at the time of issuance of the registration plates and shall be displayed on the rear registration plate in a manner to be determined by the Secretary.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 3-412 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-412) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-412)

Sec. 3-412. Registration plates and registration stickers
to be furnished by the Secretary of State.

9 (a) The Secretary of State upon registering a vehicle subject to annual registration for the first time shall issue 10 or shall cause to be issued to the owner one registration plate 11 for a motorcycle, trailer, semitrailer, motorized pedalcycle 12 13 or truck-tractor, 2 registration plates for other motor 14 vehicles and, where applicable, current registration stickers for motor vehicles of the first division. The provisions of 15 16 this Section may be made applicable to such vehicles of the 17 second division, as the Secretary of State may, from time to time, in his discretion designate. On subsequent annual 18 19 registrations during the term of the registration plate as provided in Section 3-414.1, the Secretary shall issue or cause 20 21 to be issued registration stickers as evidence of current 22 registration. However, the issuance of annual registration stickers to vehicles registered under the provisions of 23

Sections 3-402.1 and 3-405.3 of this Code may not be required
 if the Secretary deems the issuance unnecessary.

(b) Every registration plate shall have displayed upon it 3 the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is 4 5 issued, the name of this State, which may be abbreviated, the year number for which it was issued, which may be abbreviated, 6 7 the phrase "Land of Lincoln" (except as otherwise provided in 8 this Code), and such other letters or numbers as the Secretary 9 may prescribe. However, for apportionment plates issued to vehicles registered under Section 3-402.1 and fleet plates 10 11 issued to vehicles registered under Section 3-405.3, the phrase 12 "Land of Lincoln" may be omitted to allow for the word "apportioned", the word "fleet", or other similar language to 13 14 displayed. Registration plates issued to a vehicle be 15 registered as a fleet vehicle may display a designation 16 determined by the Secretary.

17 The Secretary may in his discretion prescribe that letters be used as prefixes only on registration plates issued to 18 vehicles of the first division which are registered under this 19 20 Code and only as suffixes on registration plates issued to other vehicles. Every registration sticker issued as evidence 21 22 of current registration shall designate the year number for 23 which it is issued and such other letters or numbers as the Secretary may prescribe and shall be of a contrasting color 24 25 with the registration plates and registration stickers of the 26 previous year.

11 (c) Each registration plate and the required letters and 12 numerals thereon, except the year number for which issued, 13 shall be of sufficient size to be plainly readable from a 14 distance of 100 feet during daylight, and shall be coated with 15 reflectorizing material. The dimensions of the plate issued to 16 vehicles of the first division shall be 6 by 12 inches.

17 (d) The Secretary of State shall issue for every passenger 18 motor vehicle rented without a driver the same type of 19 registration plates as the type of plates issued for a private 20 passenger vehicle.

(e) The Secretary of State shall issue for every passenger
 car used as a taxicab or livery, distinctive registration
 plates.

(f) The Secretary of State shall issue for every motorcycle
 distinctive registration plates distinguishing between
 motorcycles having 150 or more cubic centimeters piston

1 displacement, or having less than 150 cubic centimeter piston 2 displacement.

3 (g) Registration plates issued to vehicles for-hire may 4 display a designation as determined by the Secretary that such 5 vehicles are for-hire.

6 (h) The Secretary of State shall issue distinctive 7 registration plates for electric vehicles.

8 (i) The Secretary of State shall issue for every public and 9 private ambulance registration plates identifying the vehicle 10 as an ambulance. The Secretary shall forward to the Department 11 of Healthcare and Family Services registration information for 12 the purpose of verification of claims filed with the Department 13 by ambulance owners for payment for services to public 14 assistance recipients.

15 (j) The Secretary of State shall issue for every public and 16 private medical carrier or rescue vehicle livery registration 17 plates displaying numbers within ranges of numbers reserved respectively for medical carriers and rescue vehicles. The 18 19 Secretary shall forward to the Department of Healthcare and 20 Family Services registration information for the purpose of 21 verification of claims filed with the Department by owners of 22 medical carriers or rescue vehicles for payment for services to 23 public assistance recipients.

(k) The Secretary of State shall issue distinctive license
plates or distinctive license plate stickers for every vehicle
exempted from subsection (a) of Section 12-503 by subsection

(g) of that Section, and by subsection (g-5) of that Section before its deletion by this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. The Secretary shall issue these plates or stickers immediately upon receiving the physician's certification required under subsection (g) of Section 12-503. New plates or stickers shall also be issued when the certification is renewed as provided in that subsection.
