Amends the Illinois Petroleum Education and Marketing Act. Removes the January 1, 2016 expiration date set for the Petroleum Resources Board. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Petroleum Education and Marketing
Act is amended by changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 728/10)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2018)

8 Sec. 10. Illinois Petroleum Resources Board.

9 (a) There is hereby created until January 1, 2016, the Illinois Petroleum Resources Board, which shall be subject to 10 the provisions of the Regulatory Sunset Act. The purpose of the 11 12 Board is to coordinate a program designed to demonstrate to the general public the importance of the Illinois oil and gas 13 14 exploration and production industry, to encourage the wise and efficient use of energy, to promote environmentally sound 15 production methods and technologies, to develop existing 16 supplies of State oil and gas resources, and to support 17 research and educational activities concerning the oil and gas 18 19 exploration and production industry.

20 (b) The Board shall be composed of 12 members to be 21 appointed as follows:

(1) Through December 31, 2006, the Governor shall makeappointments from a list of names submitted by qualified

producer associations, of which 10 shall be oil and gas producers.

3 (2) Beginning January 1, 2007, all appointments shall
4 be made by the qualified producer associations.

(c) A member of the Board shall:

be at least 25 years of age;

(2) be a resident of the State of Illinois; and

8 (3) have at least 5 years of active experience in the 9 oil industry.

10 (d) Members shall serve for a term of 3 years, except that 11 of the initial appointments, 4 members shall serve for one 12 year, 4 members for 2 years, and 4 members for 3 years.

(e) Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term ofoffice in the same manner as the original appointment.

(f) The Board shall, at its first meeting, elect one of its members as chairperson, who shall preside over meetings of the Board and perform other duties that may be required by the Board. The first meeting of the Board shall be called by the Governor.

(g) No member of the Board shall receive a salary or
reimbursement for duties performed as a member of the Board,
except that members are eligible to receive reimbursement for
travel expenses incurred in the performance of Board duties.
