SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/6-141.1 30 ILCS 805/8.32 new from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 6-141.1

Amends the Chicago Firefighter Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Changes the amount of a widow's annuity for a deceased fireman that was receiving a retirement annuity at the time of his death to the greater of 50% of the amount of such retirement annuity at the time of the fireman's death or the salary of an active firefighter with 5 years of service at the time of the fireman's death. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing
Section 6-141.1 as follows:

6 (40 ILCS 5/6-141.1) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 6-141.1)

Sec. 6-141.1. Widow's annuity; death after June 30, 1984.

8 (a) Notwithstanding the other provisions of this Article, 9 the widow of a fireman who dies on or after June 30, 1984, 10 while receiving a retirement annuity or while an active fireman 11 with at least 1 1/2 years of creditable service, may elect to 12 have the amount of widow's annuity calculated in accordance 13 with this Section.

14 (b) If the deceased fireman was an active fireman at the time of his death and had at least 1 1/2 years of creditable 15 16 service, the widow's annuity shall be the greater of (1) 30% of 17 the salary attached to the rank of first class firefighter in the classified career service at the time of the fireman's 18 death, or (2) 50% of the retirement annuity the deceased 19 fireman would have been eligible to receive if he had retired 20 21 from service on the day before his death.

(c) If the deceased fireman was receiving a retirementannuity at the time of his death, the widow's annuity shall be
