Amends the Public Utilities Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the definition of "telecommunications carrier".

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by changing Section 13-202 as follows:
- 6 (220 ILCS 5/13-202) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 13-202)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on July 1, 2009)
- Sec. 13-202. "Telecommunications carrier" means <u>and</u> and includes every corporation, company, association, joint stock company or association, firm, partnership or individual, their lessees, trustees or receivers appointed by any court
- 12 whatsoever that owns, controls, operates or manages, within
- this State, directly or indirectly, for public use, any plant,
- 14 equipment or property used or to be used for or in connection
- 15 with, or owns or controls any franchise, license, permit or
- 16 right to engage in the provision of, telecommunications
- services between points within the State which are specified by
- 18 the user. Telecommunications carrier does not include,
- 19 however:
- 20 (a) telecommunications carriers that are owned and
- 21 operated by any political subdivision, public or private
- 22 institution of higher education or municipal corporation of
- 23 this State, for their own use, or telecommunications carriers

- 1 that are owned by such political subdivision, public or private
- 2 institution of higher education, or municipal corporation and
- 3 operated by any of its lessees or operating agents, for their
- 4 own use;
- 5 (b) telecommunications carriers which are purely mutual
- 6 concerns, having no rates or charges for services, but paying
- 7 the operating expenses by assessment upon the members of such a
- 8 company and no other person but does include telephone or
- 9 telecommunications cooperatives as defined in Section 13-212;
- 10 (c) a company or person which provides telecommunications
- 11 services solely to itself and its affiliates or members or
- between points in the same building, or between closely located
- buildings, affiliated through substantial common ownership,
- 14 control or development; or
- 15 (d) a company or person engaged in the delivery of
- 16 community antenna television services as described in
- 17 subdivision (c) of Section 13-203, except with respect to the
- 18 provision of telecommunications services by that company or
- 19 person.
