Amends the School Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 2-3.25n as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.25n)
- Sec. 2-3.25n. No Child Left Behind Act; requirements and
- 8 construction.
- 9 (a)  $\underline{\text{The}}$  changes in the State accountability system made
- 10 by this amendatory Act of the 93rd General Assembly are a
- direct result of the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001
- 12 (Public Law 107-110), which requires that each state develop
- 13 and implement a single, statewide accountability system
- 14 applicable to all schools and school districts.
- 15 (b) As provided in the federal No Child Left Behind Act of
- 16 2001 (Public Law 107-110), nothing in this amendatory Act of
- 17 the 93rd General Assembly shall be construed to alter or
- otherwise affect the rights, remedies, and procedures afforded
- 19 school district or school employees under federal, State, or
- 20 local law (including applicable rules, regulations, or court
- orders) or under the terms of collective bargaining agreements,
- 22 memoranda of understanding, or other agreements between such
- employees and their employers.
