- 9 Section 15. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground
 11 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois
 12 Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call
 13 Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground
 14 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act.
- Section 20. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for refunds.
- Section 25. The sum of \$56,600,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for grants to emergency telephone system boards, qualified

- 1 government entities, or the Department of State Police for
- 2 the design, implementation, operation, maintenance, or
- 3 upgrade of wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency services and
- 4 public safety answering points.
- 5 Section 30. The sum of \$12,500,000, or so much thereof
- 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless
- 7 Carrier Reimbursement Fund to the Illinois Commerce
- 8 Commission for reimbursement of wireless carriers for costs
- 9 incurred in complying with the applicable provisions of
- 10 Federal Communications Commission wireless enhanced 9-1-1
- 11 services mandates and for administrative costs incurred by
- 12 the Illinois Commerce Commission related to administering the
- 13 program.
- 14 Section 40. The amount of \$3,591,709, or so much thereof
- 15 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
- 16 business on June 30, 2008, from an appropriation heretofore
- 17 made for such purpose in Article 195, Section 40 of Public
- 18 Act 95-348, is reappropriated from the Digital Divide
- 19 Elimination Infrastructure Fund to the Illinois Commerce
- 20 Commission for grants and awards for the construction of
- 21 high-speed data transmission facilities.
- 22 Section 45. The following named amounts, or so much

20	Section 50. The sum of \$7,000,000, or so much thereof as
21	may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation
22	Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1)
23	disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance
24	Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration

- 1 System; (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for
- 2 administrative expenses.
- 3 Section 55. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as
- 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation
- 5 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for
- 6 railroad crossing improvement initiatives.
- 7 Section 60. The sum of \$2,090,800, or so much thereof as
- 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation
- 9 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for the
- 10 costs associated with the implementation of Senate Bill 435,
- 11 the Illinois Commercial Safety Towing Law. This section is
- operative only if Senate Bill 435 of the 95th General Assembly
- 13 becomes law.
- 14 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 15 1, 2008.
