1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6360

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6360, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu
4 thereof the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those
7 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
8 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the
9 Office of the Secretary of State to meet the ordinary,
10 contingent, and distributive expenses of the following
11 organizational units of the Office of the Secretary of State:

12 Section 10. The following amount, or so much of this
13 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of

1 the Secretary of State for any operations, alterations,
 2 rehabilitation, and nonrecurring repairs and maintenance of
 3 the interior and exterior of the various buildings and
 4 facilities under the jurisdiction of the Office of the
 5 Secretary of State, including sidewalks, terraces, and
 6 grounds and all labor, materials, and other costs incidental
 7 to the above work:

8 From General Revenue Fund425,000

9 Section 15. The sum of \$875,000, or so much of this
 10 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
 11 Development Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
 12 new construction and alterations, and maintenance of the
 13 interiors and exteriors of the following facilities under the
 14 jurisdiction of the Secretary of State: Chicago West
 15 Facility, 5301 N. Lexington Ave., Chicago, Illinois 60644;
 16 Roger McAuliffe Facility, 5401 N. Elston Ave., Chicago,
 17 Illinois 60630; Charles Chew Jr. Facility, 9901 S. King
 18 Drive, Chicago, Illinois 60628; and Capitol Complex buildings
 19 located in Springfield Illinois.

20 Section 25. The amount of \$40,000, or so much thereof as
 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Parking
 22 Facility Maintenance Fund to the Secretary of State for the
 23 maintenance of parking facilities owned or operated by the

1 Secretary of State.

2 Section 30. The following amounts, or so much of these
3 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
4 to the Office of the Secretary of State for the following
5 purposes:

6 For annual equalization grants, per capita and area grants to
7 library systems, and per capita grants to public libraries,
8 under Section 8 of the Illinois Library System Act. This
9 amount is in addition to any amount otherwise appropriated to
10 the Office of the Secretary of State:

11	From General Revenue Fund	16,668,400
12	From Live and Learn Fund	16,004,200

13 Section 35. The following amounts, or so much of these
14 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
15 to the Office of the Secretary of State for library services
16 for the blind and physically handicapped:

17	From General Revenue Fund	2,427,200
18	From Live and Learn Fund	300,000
19	From Accessible Electronic Information	
20	Service Fund	40,000

21 Section 40. The following amounts, or so much of these
22 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated

1 to the Office of the Secretary of State for the following
2 purposes:

3 For annual per capita grants to all school districts of the
4 State for the establishment and operation of qualified school
5 libraries or the additional support of existing qualified
6 school libraries under Section 8.4 of the Illinois Library
7 System Act. This amount is in addition to any amount
8 otherwise appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of
9 State:

- 10 From General Revenue Fund375,000
- 11 From Live and Learn Fund1,025,000

12 Section 45. The following amount, or so much of this
13 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
14 the Secretary of State for grants to library systems for
15 library computers and new technologies to promote and improve
16 interlibrary cooperation and resource sharing programs among
17 Illinois libraries:

- 18 From Live and Learn Fund274,000
- 19 From Secretary of State Special Services Fund226,000

20 Section 50. The following amounts, or so much of these
21 amounts as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Office
22 of the Secretary of State for annual library technology
23 grants and for direct purchase of equipment and services that

1 support library development and technology advancement in
2 libraries statewide:

3	From General Revenue Fund	664,900
4	From Live and Learn Fund	0
5	From Secretary of State Special	
6	Services Fund	<u>1,600,000</u>
7	Total	\$2,264,900

8 Section 55. The following amount, or so much of this
9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
10 the Secretary of State from the Live and Learn Fund for the
11 purpose of making grants to libraries for construction and
12 renovation as provided in Section 8 of the Illinois Library
13 System Act. This amount is in addition to any amount
14 otherwise appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of
15 State:

16	From Live and Learn Fund	620,800

17 Section 60. The following amounts, or so much of these
18 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
19 to the Office of the Secretary of State for the following
20 purposes: For library services under the Federal Library
21 Services and Technology Act, P.L. 104-208, as amended; and
22 the National Foundation on the Arts and Humanities Act of
23 1965, P.L. 89-209. These amounts are in addition to any

1 amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
2 of State:

3 From Federal Library Services Fund:6,800,000

4 Section 65. The following amounts, or so much of these
5 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
6 to the Office of the Secretary of State for support and
7 expansion of the Literacy Programs administered by education
8 agencies, libraries, volunteers, or community based
9 organizations or a coalition of any of the above:

10 From General Revenue Fund4,650,000

11 From Live and Learn Fund500,000

12 From Federal Library Services Fund:

13 From LSTA Title IA0

14 From Secretary of State Special

15 Services Fund1,300,000

16 Section 70. The following amount, or so much of this
17 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
18 the Secretary of State for tuition and fees and other
19 expenses related to the program for Illinois Archival
20 Depository System Interns:

21 From General Revenue Fund45,000

22 Section 75. The sum of \$250,000, or so much of this

1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
 2 Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for the
 3 Penny Severns Summer Family Literacy Grants.

4 Section 80. In addition to any other amounts appropriated
 5 for such purposes, the sum of \$1,700,000, or so much of this
 6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
 7 Revenue Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for a grant
 8 to the Chicago Public Library.

9 Section 85. The sum of \$325,000, or so much of this
 10 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
 11 Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for all
 12 expenditures and grants to libraries for the Project Next
 13 Generation Program.

14 Section 90. The following amount, or so much of this
 15 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
 16 the Secretary of State from the Live and Learn Fund for the
 17 purpose of promotion of organ and tissue donations:

18 From Live and Learn Fund1,750,000

19 Section 95. The sum of \$50,000, or so much of this amount
 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of
 21 State Special License Plate Fund to the Office of the

1 Secretary of State for grants to benefit Illinois Veterans
2 Home libraries.

3 Section 100. The amount of \$45,000, or so much of this
4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
5 the Secretary of State from the Master Mason Fund to provide
6 grants to the Illinois Masonic Foundation for the Prevention
7 of Drug and Alcohol Abuse Among Children, Inc., a not-for-
8 profit corporation, for the purpose of providing Model
9 Student Assistance Programs in public and private schools in
10 Illinois.

11 Section 105. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
13 from the Illinois Pan Hellenic Trust Fund to provide grants
14 for charitable purposes sponsored by African-American
15 fraternities and sororities.

16 Section 110. The amount of \$15,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
18 from the Park District Youth Program Fund to provide grants
19 for the Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School
20 Programming.

21 Section 115. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
2 from the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to provide
3 grants for the development of tourism, education,
4 preservation and promotion of Route 66.

5 Section 120. The sum of \$80,000, or so much of this
6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Police
7 Memorial Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
8 State for grants to the Police Memorial Committee for
9 maintaining a memorial statue, holding an annual memorial
10 commemoration, and giving scholarships to children to police
11 officers killed in the line of duty.

12 Section 125. The sum of \$100,000, or so much of this
13 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
14 Mammogram Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
15 grants to the Susan G. Komen Foundation for breast cancer
16 research, education, screening, and treatment.

17 Section 130. The following amounts, or so much of these
18 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
19 to the Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in
20 Section 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), for
21 grants to the Regional Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-
22 America Transplant Services for the purpose of promotion of

1 organ and tissue donation awareness. These amounts are in
2 addition to any amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office
3 of the Secretary of State:

4 From Organ Donor Awareness Fund125,000

5 Section 135. The amount of \$0, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
7 the Chicago and Northeast Illinois District Council of
8 Carpenters Fund to provide grants for charitable purposes.

9 Section 140. The amount of \$40,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
11 from the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide grants
12 for scholarships for Higher Education.

13 Section 190. The amount of \$500,000, or so much of this
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Office
15 of the Secretary of State Grant Fund to the Office of the
16 Secretary of State to be expended in accordance with the
17 terms and conditions upon which such funds were received.

18 Section 235. The amount of \$20,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
20 from the Illinois Professional Golfers Association Junior
21 Golf Fund for grants to the Illinois Professional Golfers

1 Association Foundation to help Association members expose
2 Illinois youngsters to the game of golf.

3 Section 240. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
5 from the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to
6 support Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public
7 and private schools within Illinois.

8 Section 245. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
10 from the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Fund for grants to the
11 Illinois divisions of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl
12 Scouts of the U.S.A.

13 ARTICLE 999

14 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect
15 July 1, 2008."
