2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6415, by deleting 3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu 4 thereof the following:

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"ARTICLE 1

20 Section 10. Whenever it becomes necessary for the State 21 or any governmental unit to furnish in a disaster area

emergency services directly related to or required by a 1 disaster and existing funds are insufficient to provide such 2 services, the Governor may, when he considers such action in 3 the best interest of the State, release funds from the 4 General Revenue Disaster Relief appropriation in order to 5 6 provide such services or to reimburse local governmental bodies furnishing such services. 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ARTICLE 998

5 Section 998. Each of the amounts appropriated in this 6 Act (after all actions by the Governor and the General 7 Assembly) controls over any lower amount appropriated in any 8 other Public Act (after all actions by the Governor and the 9 General Assembly) for the same purpose unless that other 10 Public Act expressly states otherwise.

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
