11 WHEREAS, Gertrude was the loving mother of Judith Case, 12 Toni Fahey, Jay Trunda, Christopher Trunda, Cathy Heer, Thomas 13 Trunda, and Patrick Trunda; she was also the grandmother of 17 14 and the great-grandmother of 13; and
