SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 320/7.2

from Ch. 128, par. 107.2

Amends the State Library Act. With respect to the Literacy Advisory Board, provides that 7 members shall be appointed by the Secretary of State from Illinois citizens interested in the literacy issue (now, 2 of the members are from the State Library, 2 from the State Board of Education, and 3 from citizens interested in literacy issues).

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Library Act is amended by changing Section 7.2 as follows:
- 6 (15 ILCS 320/7.2) (from Ch. 128, par. 107.2)
- 7 Sec. 7.2. Literacy Advisory Board. There is created a Literacy Advisory Board, consisting of the Secretary of State 8 9 or his or her designee, as chairperson, and 7 2 members from the Illinois State Library or their designees, 2 members from 10 the Illinois State Board of Education or their designees and 3 11 12 Illinois citizens interested in the literacy issue, appointed by the Secretary of State. The Literacy Advisory 13 14 Board shall review community and workplace proposals for funding of literacy programs in Illinois submitted through the 15 Office of the Secretary of State and recommend to the Secretary 16 17 of State those deserving of funding. The Illinois State Library may promulgate rules and regulations to establish standards for 18
