1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 8-3-5 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/8-3-5) (from Ch. 24, par. 8-3-5)
- 7 Sec. 8-3-5. All taxes levied by a municipality, except
- 8 special assessments for local improvements, shall be uniform
- 9 upon all taxable property and and persons within the limits of
- 10 the municipality, and no property shall be exempt therefrom
- other than such property as may be exempt from taxation under
- 12 the constitution and general laws of the State.
