2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 3-626 as follows:

Sec. 3-626. Korean War Veteran license plates.

8 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the the 9 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may 10 issue special registration plates designated as Korean War 11 12 Veteran license plates to residents of Illinois who participated in the United States Armed Forces during the 13 14 Korean War. The special plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 15 16 motorcycles, motor vehicles of the second division weighing not 17 more than 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under this Section 18 19 shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 20

(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412.

8 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original 9 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. Of 10 this additional fee, \$13 shall be deposited into the Secretary 11 of State Special License Plate Fund and \$2 shall be deposited 12 into the Korean War Memorial Construction Fund.

13 (d) The Korean War Memorial Construction Fund is created as 14 a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Korean 15 War Memorial Construction Fund shall, subject to 16 appropriation, be used by the Department of Veteran Affairs to 17 provide grants for construction of the Korean War Memorial to be located at Oak Ridge Cemetery in Springfield, Illinois. Upon 18 19 the completion of the Memorial, the Department of Veteran Affairs shall certify to the State Treasurer that 20 the construction of the Memorial has been completed. Upon the 21 22 certification by the Department of Veteran Affairs, the State 23 Treasurer shall transfer all moneys in the Fund and any future deposits into the Fund into the Secretary of State Special 24 25 License Plate Fund.

(e) An individual who has been issued Korean War Veteran

license plates for a vehicle and who has been approved for benefits under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act shall pay the original issuance and the regular annual fee for the registration of the vehicle as provided in Section 3-806.3 of this Code in addition to the fees specified in subsection (c) of this Section.
