SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

60 ILCS 1/25-10-5 new

Amends the Township Code. Provides that township organization may cease in an individual township if three-fourths of the registered voters in the township vote against the continuance of township organization. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning local government. 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Township Code is amended by adding Section 5 25-10-5 as follows:
- (60 ILCS 1/25-10-5 new)6
- 7 Sec. 25-10-5. Cessation of township organization within an individual township. Upon the petition of at least 10% of the 8 9 registered voters of an individual township, the township board 10 shall certify and cause to be submitted to the voters of the township, at the next general election, the question of whether 11 township organization shall continue in that township. The 12
- 14 "Shall township organization be continued in (name of township)?"

proposition shall be substantially in the form:

- 16 If it appears by the returns of the election that at least 17 three-fourths of the registered voters in the township are against the continuance of township organization, then 18 19 township organization shall cease in that township.
- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 21 becoming law.
