BALANCED BUDGET NOTE ACT MAY APPLY SB3026

AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 5 Fund to the Department of Corrections for a grant to the Cook 6 County Sheriff's Office for programs administered through the 7 Department of Women's Justice Services, for the Cook County 8 Residential Treatment and Transition Center for 9 Women, including but not limited to, mental health 10 and druq rehabilitation issues. 11

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect uponbecoming law.
