WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 2 3 learn of the death of Donald E. Greer, who passed away on May 4 24, 2007; and 5 WHEREAS, Donald E. Greer was born June 30, 1951, in Alton 6 to Donald L. and Jean (Brinkman) Greer; he graduated from Civic 7 Memorial High School and received his bachelor's degree from 8 McKendree College and master's degree from Southern Illinois 9 University in Edwardsville; in the early 1990s he attended the 10 FBI Academy; and WHEREAS, Donald Greer was employed in Wood River as a 11 12 officer, then became police chief 13 administrator; he also served as the director of administration 14 for the Madison County state's attorney's office; and 15 WHEREAS, In June of 1990, he moved to Crestwood, Missouri, where he served as police chief for 16 years, became city 16 administrator in December 2002, and left in September 2005; he 17 18 was city administrator in Fairview Heights for the last year; 19 and

WHEREAS, Donald Greer was preceded in death by his father;
