#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/9-2-100

from Ch. 24, par. 9-2-100

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. In a Section pertaining to the letting of bids by certain municipalities, provides that any work or other public improvement, to be paid for in whole or in part by special assessment or special taxation, when the expense thereof will exceed \$10,000 (instead of \$500), shall be constructed by contract let to the lowest responsible bidder. Provides that work estimated to cost no more than \$10,000 (instead of \$500) shall be performed by the corporate authorities of the municipality under specified circumstances. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by  
5 changing Section 9-2-100 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/9-2-100) (from Ch. 24, par. 9-2-100)

7 Sec. 9-2-100. Except as otherwise provided in Section  
8 9-2-113, any work or other public improvement, to be paid for  
9 in whole or in part by special assessment or special taxation,  
10 when the expense thereof will exceed \$10,000 ~~\$500~~, shall be  
11 constructed by contract let to the lowest responsible bidder in  
12 the manner prescribed in this Division 2. Such contracts shall  
13 be approved by the president of the board of local  
14 improvements.

15 In case of any work which it is estimated will not cost  
16 more than \$10,000 ~~\$500~~, if after receiving bids it appears to  
17 the board of local improvements that the work can be performed  
18 better and cheaper by the municipality, the corporate  
19 authorities of the municipality shall perform that work and  
20 employ the necessary help therefor. The cost of that work by  
21 the municipality in no case shall be more than the lowest bid  
22 received.
