Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Section 16-104e as follows:

Sec. 16-104e. Offenses against traffic regulations governing the movement of vehicles; double fines. A person who commits 3 offenses against traffic regulations governing the movement of vehicles within any 12 month period, in addition to any other penalty imposed by the court, shall be fined twice the amount authorized for the offense.
