AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 528

AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 528 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following:

"Section 5. The Medical Patient Rights Act is amended by

changing Section 5 and adding Sections 5.1 and 5.2 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 50/5)

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7 Sec. 5. Statement of hospital patient's rights.

(a) Each patient admitted to a hospital, and the guardian or authorized representative or parent of a minor patient, shall be given a written statement of all the rights enumerated in this Act, or a similar statement of patients' rights required of the hospital by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations or a similar accrediting organization. The statement shall be given at the time of admission or as soon thereafter as the condition of the patient permits.

- 1 (b) If a patient is unable to read the written statement, a
 2 hospital shall make a reasonable effort to provide it to the
- guardian or authorized representative of the patient.
- 4 (c) The statement shall also include the right not to be
- 5 <u>discriminated against by the hospital due to the patient's</u>
- 6 race, color, or national origin where such characteristics are
- 7 <u>not relevant to the patient's medical diagnosis and treatment.</u>
- 8 The statement shall further provide each admitted patient or
- 9 the patient's representative or guardian with notice of how to
- 10 initiate a grievance regarding improper discrimination with
- 11 the hospital and how the patient may lodge a grievance with the
- 12 Illinois Department of Public Health regardless of whether the
- 13 patient has first used the hospital's grievance process.

- Sec. 5.1. Discrimination grievance procedures. Upon
- 17 receipt of a grievance alleging unlawful discrimination on the
- 18 <u>basis of race, col</u>or, or national origin, the hospital must
- investigate the claim and work with the patient to address
- valid or proven concerns in accordance with the hospital's
- 21 grievance process. At the conclusion of the hospital's
- grievance process, the hospital shall inform the patient that
- 23 <u>such grievances may be reported to the Illinois Department of</u>
- 24 Public Health if not resolved to the patient's satisfaction at
- 25 <u>the hospital level.</u>

- 1 (410 ILCS 50/5.2 new)
- Sec. 5.2. Emergency room anti-discrimination notice. Every
- 3 <u>hospital shall post a sign next to or in close proximity of its</u>
- 4 sign required by Section 489.20 (q) (1) of Title 42 of the Code
- of Federal Regulations stating the following:
- 6 "You have the right not to be discriminated against by the
- 7 <u>hospital due to your race, color, or national origin if these</u>
- 8 characteristics are unrelated to your diagnosis or treatment.
- 9 If you believe this right has been violated, please call
- 10 (insert number for hospital grievance officer)."
- 11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 12 becoming law.".
