Amends the Election Code. Beginning January 1, 2011, permits an election authority to accept in-person voter registrations on the day of the consolidated primary election and the day of the consolidated election.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding Sections 4-110, 5-110, and 6-110 as follows:
