1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2145

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2145 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. "Operational expenses" defined. For the
6 purposes of this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly,
7 the term "operational expenses" includes the following items:

- 8 (a) Personal services;
- 9 (b) State contributions to Social Security;
- 10 (c) Group Insurance;
- 11 (d) Contractual services, except that professional and
12 artistic services shall not be included in the definition of
13 "operational expenses";
- 14 (e) Travel;

- 1 (f) Commodities;
- 2 (g) Printing;
- 3 (h) Equipment;
- 4 (i) Electronic data processing;
- 5 (j) Telecommunications services;
- 6 (k) Operation of automotive equipment;
- 7 (l) Refunds.

8 Section 10. "Professional and artistic services" defined.
9 For the purposes of this amendatory Act of the 96th General
10 Assembly, the term "professional and artistic services" means
11 those services provided under contract to a State agency by a
12 person or business, acting as an independent contractor,
13 qualified by education, experience, and technical ability.

14 ARTICLE 2

15 Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof
16 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
17 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
18 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section
19 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of
20 their respective houses throughout the year in connection
21 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in
22 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law.

1 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of
2 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated
3 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

4 Section 10. Payments from the amounts appropriated in
5 Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a
6 voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The
7 voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate
8 or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case
9 may be.

10 Section 15. The amount of \$20,603,400 or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet
12 the ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate
13 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and
14 the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general
15 staff and office operations. Of this amount, 25.7% is
16 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
17 expenditures, 25.7% is appropriated to the Senate Minority
18 Leader for such expenditures and 24.8% is appropriated to the
19 Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 23.8% is
20 appropriated to the House Minority Leader for such
21 expenditures.

22 Section 20. The amount of \$9,382,100, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
2 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
3 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of
4 committees, the general staff and operations, per diem
5 employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred
6 in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount,
7 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for
8 such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker
9 of the House for such expenditures.

10 Section 25. The amount of \$309,200, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
12 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
13 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses,
14 also including the purchasing on contract as required by law
15 of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office
16 supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended
17 for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such
18 supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred
19 without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of
20 Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to
21 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723%
22 is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
23 expenditures.

1 Section 30. The amount of \$4,483,050, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
3 President of the Senate for the use of standing committees
4 for expert witnesses, technical services, consulting
5 assistance and other research assistance associated with
6 special studies and long range research projects which may be
7 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the
8 House of Representatives for Standing House Committees
9 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of
10 1984. Of this amount, 46.862% is appropriated to the
11 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 53.138% is
12 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
13 expenditures.

14 Section 35. The amount of \$167,000, or so much thereof
15 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
16 President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for
17 allowances for the particular and additional services
18 appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the
19 Senate. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to the President
20 of the Senate for such expenditures and 50% is appropriated
21 to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures.

22 Section 40. The amount of \$88,100, or so much thereof as
23 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the

1 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
2 Representatives for travel, including expenses to Springfield
3 of members on official legislative business during weeks when
4 the General Assembly is not in session. Of this amount,
5 65.5% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
6 expenditures and 34.5% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
7 House for such expenditures.

8 Section 45. The amount of \$441,600, or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an
10 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 17
11 of Public Act 95-0731, is appropriated to the Speaker of the
12 House for expenses in connection with the planning and
13 preparation of redistricting of legislative and
14 representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3
15 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

16 Section 50. The amount of \$341,600, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent
19 expenses. Any use of funds appropriated under this Section
20 must be approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of
21 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.

22 Section 55. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where

1 the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives
2 is expressively required for the expenditure of or the
3 incurring of indebtedness against an appropriation for
4 certain purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of
5 the party having the largest number of members of the House
6 of Representatives as of January 14, 2009, and "Minority
7 Leader" means the leader of the party having the second
8 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as
9 of January 14, 2009.

10 Section 60. The sum of \$312,455, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics
12 Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of
13 the Commission and the Office of Legislative Inspector
14 General.

15 Section 65. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and contingent
17 expenses of the Senate Operations Commission including the
18 planning costs, construction costs, moving expenses and all
19 other costs associated with the construction and
20 reconstruction of Senate offices in the Capitol Complex area.

 17 transferred into or out of this line item.
