1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2145

- 2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2145 by replacing
- 3 everything after the enacting with the following:
- 4 "ARTICLE 1
- 5 Section 5. "Operational expenses" defined. For the
- 6 purposes of this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly,
- 7 the term "operational expenses" includes the following items:
- 8 (a) Personal services;
- 9 (b) State contributions to Social Security;
- 10 (c) Group Insurance;
- 11 (d) Contractual services, except that professional and
- 12 artistic services shall not be included in the definition of
- "operational expenses";
- 14 (e) Travel;

- 1 (f) Commodities;
- 2 (g) Printing;
- 3 (h) Equipment;
- 4 (i) Electronic data processing;
- 5 (j) Telecommunications services;
- 6 (k) Operation of automotive equipment;
- 7 (1) Refunds.
- 8 Section 10. "Professional and artistic services" defined.
- 9 For the purposes of this amendatory Act of the 96th General
- 10 Assembly, the term "professional and artistic services" means
- 11 those services provided under contract to a State agency by a
- 12 person or business, acting as an independent contractor,
- 13 qualified by education, experience, and technical ability.

Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof 15 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 16 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 17 18 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of 19 their respective houses throughout the year in connection 20 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in 21 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law. 22

- 1 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of
- the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated 2
- to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures. 3
- Payments from the amounts appropriated in 4 Section 10.
- 5 Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a
- voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. 6
- voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate 7
- or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case 8
- 9 may be.
- Section 15. The amount of \$20,603,400 or so much thereof 10
- as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet 11
- incidental expenses 12 ordinary and of the Senate
- legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and 13
- the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general 14
- staff and office operations. Of this amount, 15
- 16 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
- expenditures, 25.7% is appropriated to the Senate Minority 17
- Leader for such expenditures and 24.8% is appropriated to the 18
- 19 Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 23.8% is
- House Minority Leader 20 appropriated to the for such
- expenditures. 21

Section 20. The amount of \$9,382,100, or so much thereof

as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of committees, the general staff and operations, per diem employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount, 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

Section 25. The amount of \$309,200, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses, also including the purchasing on contract as required by law of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

1 Section 30. the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives 1 is expressively required for the expenditure of or 2 incurring of indebtedness against an appropriation 3 certain purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of the party having the largest number of members of the House 5 6 of Representatives as of January 14, 2009, and "Minority Leader" means the leader of the party having the second 7 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as 8 of January 14, 2009. 9

Section 60. The sum of \$312,455, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Commission and the Office of Legislative Inspector General.

Section 65.
