- 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 2145, AS AMENDED,

- 9 Section 10. "Professional and artistic services" defined.
- 10 For the purposes of this amendatory Act of the 96th General
- 11 Assembly, the term "professional and artistic services" means
- 12 those services provided under contract to a State agency by a
- 13 person or business, acting as an independent contractor,
- 14 qualified by education, experience, and technical ability.

- Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof
- 17 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
- 18 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
- 19 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section
- 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of

- Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of
- 3 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated
- 4 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.
- Section 10. Payments from the amounts appropriated in Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case
- Section 15. The amount of \$20,603,400 or so much thereof 11 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet 12 13 ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate 14 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general 15 16 staff and office operations. Of this amount, 25.7% appropriated to the President of the Senate for 17 expenditures, 25.7% is appropriated to the Senate Minority 18 19 Leader for such expenditures and 24.8% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 23.8% is 20 21 appropriated to the House Minority Leader for such 22 expenditures.

Section 20. The amount of \$9,382,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of committees, the general staff and operations, per diem employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount, 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

Section 25. The amount of \$309,200, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses, also including the purchasing on contract as required by law of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

Section 30. The amount of \$4,483,050, or so much thereof 1 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 2 President of the Senate for the use of standing committees 3 witnesses, technical services, 5 assistance and other research assistance associated with special studies and long range research projects which may be 6 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the 7 of Representatives for Standing House Committees 8 9 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 10 Of this amount, 46.862% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 53.138% is 11 12 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for 13 expenditures.

14 Section 35. The amount of \$167,000, or so much thereof 15 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 16 President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for allowances for the particular and additional services 17 appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the 18 19 Senate. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 50% is appropriated 20 to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures. 21

9 Section 45. The amount of \$441,600, or so much thereof 10 be necessary and remains unexpended from appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 17 11 of Public Act 95-0731, is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for expenses in connection with the planning preparation of redistricting of legislative and 15 representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970. 16

Section 50. The amount of \$341,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent expenses. Any use of funds appropriated under this Section must be approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.

1 Section 55. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives 2 is expressively required for the expenditure of or 3 incurring of indebtedness against an appropriation 4 certain purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of 5 6 the party having the largest number of members of the House of Representatives as of January 14, 2009, and "Minority 7 Leader" means the leader of the party having the second 8 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as 9 10 of January 14, 2009.

Section 60. The sum of \$312,455, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Commission and the Office of Legislative Inspector General.

Section 65. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Senate Operations Commission including the planning costs, construction costs, moving expenses and all other costs associated with the construction and reconstruction of Senate offices in the Capitol Complex area.
