2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 2675, AS AMENDED, by
3	replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4	following:
5	"Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
6	18-12.5 as follows:
7	(105 ILCS 5/18-12.5 new)
8	Sec. 18-12.5. State aid claims during health emergencies.
9	After consultation with a local health department, if a school
10	district closes one or more recognized school buildings, but
11	not all buildings, during a public health emergency, as
12	determined by the State Board of Education in consultation with
13	the Illinois Department of Public Health, the district may
14	claim a full day of attendance for those days based on the
15	average of the 3 school days of attendance immediately
16	preceding the closure of the school building. Attendance for

1	those days may be claimed only if the school building was
2	scheduled to be in operation on those days. The partial or no
3	day of attendance and the reasons thereof shall be certified,
4	as prescribed by the State Board of Education, within a month
5	after the closing by the school district superintendent to the
6	regional superintendent of schools for forwarding to the State
7	Superintendent of Education for approval.
8	This Section is applicable beginning April 1, 2009 and only
9	if a school district closes a building or buildings, but not
10	the entire district, which must be done in accordance with
11	Section 18-12 of this Code.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2009.".
