Amends the Downstate Firefighters, Chicago Firefighters, Chicago Municipal, and Chicago Laborers Articles of the Illinois Pension Code. Allows an active fireman who is a member of the Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago to transfer up to a total of 10 years of service credit in 6-month increments for service for covered employment under the Downstate Firefighters, Chicago Municipal, and Chicago Laborers Articles. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding Sections 4-108.6, 6-227, 8-226.8, and 11-125.9 as follows:

- Sec. 4-108.6. Transfer of creditable service to the
- 8 <u>Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago.</u>
- 9 (a) Until January 1, 2010, any active member of the
- 10 Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago may apply for
- 11 <u>transfer of up to 10 years of creditable service accumulated in</u>
- 12 any pension fund established under this Article to the
- 13 Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago. Such creditable
- 14 <u>service shall be transferred only upon payment by such pension</u>
- fund to the Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago of an
- 16 amount equal to:
- 17 <u>(1) the amounts accumulated to the credit of the</u>
- applicant on the books of the fund on the date of transfer;
- 19 (2) employer contributions in an amount equal to the
- amount determined under subparagraph (1); and

13	implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
14	the 96th General Assembly.
