SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1605/2 from Ch. 120, par. 1152 20 ILCS 1605/20 from Ch. 120, par. 1170 20 ILCS 1605/21.9 new 30 ILCS 105/5.719 new

Amends the Illinois Lottery Law. Requires the Department of Revenue to offer a special instant scratch-off game, named scratch-out multiple sclerosis, to commence on July 1, 2009. Provides that the net revenue from the scratch-off game shall be deposited into the Multiple Sclerosis Research Fund for appropriation to the Department of Public Health for grants to organizations in Illinois conducting research pertaining to the repair of damage caused by an acquired demyelinating disease of the central nervous system. Defines "research". Sets forth certain provisions for the operation of the scratch-off game. Imposes conditions on rulemaking authority. Amends the State Finance Act to create the Multiple Sclerosis Research Fund. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly:

- 17 (a) There is created in the State Treasury a special fund
- to be known as the "State Lottery Fund". Such fund shall 18
- consist of all revenues received from (1) the sale of lottery 19
- 20 tickets or shares, (net of commissions, fees representing those
- 21 expenses that are directly proportionate to the sale of tickets
- or shares at the agent location, and prizes of less than \$600 22

- 4 pursuant to law. Interest earnings of the State Lottery Fund

- Sec. 21.9. Scratch-out Multiple Sclerosis scratch-off
- 21 game.
- 22 (a) The Department shall offer a special instant
- 23 scratch-off game for the benefit of research pertaining to
- 24 multiple sclerosis. The game shall commence on July 1, 2009 or
- as soon thereafter, in the discretion of the Director, as is

- 2 governed by this Act and any rules adopted by the Department.
- 3 If any provision of this Section is inconsistent with any other
- 4 provision of this Act, then this Section governs.
- 5 (b) The Multiple Sclerosis Research Fund is created as a
- 6 special fund in the State treasury. The net revenue from the
- 7 <u>scratch-out multiple sclerosis scratch-off game created under</u>
- 8 this Section shall be deposited into the Fund for appropriation
- 9 by the General Assembly to the Department of Public Health for
- 10 the purpose of making grants to organizations in Illinois that
- 11 conduct research pertaining to the repair of damage caused by
- 12 an acquired demyelinating disease of the central nervous
- 13 system.
- 14 Moneys received for the purposes of this Section,
- including, without limitation, net revenue from the special
- 16 instant scratch-off game and from gifts, grants, and awards
- from any public or private entity, must be deposited into the
- 18 Fund. Any interest earned on moneys in the Fund must be
- deposited into the Fund.
- For purposes of this Section, the term "research" includes,
- 21 without limitation, expenditures to develop and advance the
- 22 understanding, techniques, and modalities effective for
- 23 maintaining function, mobility, and strength through
- 24 preventive physical therapy or other treatments and to develop
- 25 and advance the repair of myelin, neuron, and axon damage
- 26 caused by an acquired demyelinating disease of the central

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- nervous system and the restoration of function, including but 1 2 not limited to, nervous system repair or neuroregeneration. The 3 grant funds may not be used for institutional, organizational, or community-based overhead costs, indirect costs, or levies. 4 For purposes of this subsection, "net revenue" means the total 5 amount for which tickets have been sold less the sum of the 6 7 amount paid out in the prizes and the actual administrative 8 expenses of the Department solely related to the scratch-off
- 10 <u>(c) During the time that tickets are sold for the</u>
 11 <u>scratch-out multiple sclerosis scratch-off game, the</u>
 12 <u>Department shall not unreasonably diminish the efforts devoted</u>
 13 to marketing any other instant scratch-off lottery game.
 - implement and administer the provisions of this Section.

 Rulemaking authority to implement this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly, however, is conditioned on the rules being adopted in accordance with all provisions of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act and all rules and procedures of the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules; any purported rule not so adopted, for whatever reason, is unauthorized.
