SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

25 ILCS 115/2.1 new

Amends the General Assembly Compensation Act. Provides that, if the General Assembly, by law, requires any State employees to take one or more unpaid days off as furlough days, then each and every member of the General Assembly is mandatorily required to take at least an equivalent number of unpaid days off as furlough days in the same period during which the employees must take the furlough days. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The General Assembly Compensation Act is amended
by adding Section 2.1 as follows:

7 Sec. 2.1. Furlough days. If the General Assembly, by law,
8 requires any State employees to take one or more unpaid days
9 off as furlough days, then each and every member of the General
10 Assembly is mandatorily required to take at least an equivalent
11 number of unpaid days off as furlough days in the same period
12 during which the employees must take the furlough days.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
