SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 490/150 new

Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Designates each February 28th as a day for the commemoration of and reflection upon the contributions of African American slaves to Illinois and the United States. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
- 5 adding Section 150 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/150 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 150. Commemoration of contributions of African</u>
- 8 American slaves. February 28 of each year is designated as a
- 9 day for the people of this State to commemorate and reflect
- 10 upon the contributions of African American slaves to Illinois
- and to the United States.
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 13 becoming law.
