SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5-5.4f new

Amends the Medical Assistance Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that if medical assistance reimbursements to any category of medical assistance providers are payable based on a shortened or maximum payment cycle as part of an agreement with the federal government to receive an enhanced federal matching rate, then medical assistance reimbursements for hospice services shall also be made pursuant to such shortened or maximum payment cycle. Effective immediately.

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by

7 Sec. 5-5.4f. Hospice services payment cycle. If medical
8 assistance reimbursements to any category of medical
9 assistance providers are payable based on a shortened or
10 maximum payment cycle as part of an agreement with the federal
11 government to receive an enhanced federal matching rate, then
12 medical assistance reimbursements for hospice services shall
13 also be made pursuant to such shortened or maximum payment
14 cycle.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
16 becoming law.
