1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing Section 11-9.1 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/11-9.1) (from Ch. 38, par. 11-9.1)
- 7 Sec. 11-9.1. Sexual exploitation of a child.
- 8 (a) Any person commits sexual exploitation of a child if in
  9 the presence or virtual presence, or both, of a child and with
  10 intent or knowledge that a child or one whom he or she believes
- 11 to be a child would view his or her acts, that person:
- 12 (1) engages in a sexual act; or
- 13 (2) exposes his or her sex organs, anus or breast for 14 the purpose of sexual arousal or gratification of such 15 person or the child <u>or one whom he or she believes to be a</u>
- 16 <u>child</u>.
- (a-5) A person commits sexual exploitation of a child who
- 18 knowingly entices, coerces, or persuades a child to remove the
- 19 child's clothing for the purpose of sexual arousal or
- gratification of the person or the child, or both.
- 21 (b) Definitions. As used in this Section:
- "Sexual act" means masturbation, sexual conduct or sexual
- penetration as defined in Section 12-12 of this Code.

"Sex offense" means any violation of Article 11 of this 1

2 Code or a violation of Section 12-13, 12-14, 12-14.1, 12-15,

- 12-16, or 12-16.2 of this Code. 3
- 4 "Child" means a person under 17 years of age.
- 5 "Virtual presence" means an environment that is created
- with software and presented to the user and or receiver via the 6
- Internet, in such a way that the user appears in front of the 7
- receiver on the computer monitor or screen or hand held 8
- 9 portable electronic device, usually through a web camming
- program. "Virtual presence" includes primarily experiencing 10
- 11 through sight or sound, or both, a video image that can be
- 12 explored interactively at a personal <u>computer or hand held</u>
- 13 communication device, or both.
- 14 "Webcam" means a video capturing device connected to a
- 15 computer or computer network that is designed to take digital
- 16 photographs or live or recorded video which allows for the live
- 17 transmission to an end user over the Internet.
- 18 (c) Sentence.
- (1) Sexual exploitation of a child is a Class A 19
- 20 misdemeanor. A second or subsequent violation of this
- 21 Section or a substantially similar law of another state is
- 22 a Class 4 felony.
- 23 (2) Sexual exploitation of a child is a Class 4 felony
- if the person has been previously convicted of a sex 24
- 25 offense.
- 26 (3) Sexual exploitation of a child is a Class 4 felony

- if the victim was under 13 years of age at the time of the 1
- commission of the offense. 2
