### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

705 ILCS 105/12.1 new

Amends the Clerks of Courts Act. Provides that when the circuit clerk is required to provide notice to a party, and the party has registered an electronic address with the circuit clerk, the circuit clerk may provide the notice via the electronic address. Provides that the circuit clerk shall maintain a copy of the electronic content and a delivery receipt in his or her records. Provides that electronic notices shall have the same effect as a hard copy notice. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Clerks of Courts Act is amended by adding
Section 12.1 as follows:

6 (705 ILCS 105/12.1 new)

7 Sec. 12.1. Electronic notice. When the circuit clerk is required to provide notice to a party, and the party has 8 9 registered an electronic address with the circuit clerk, the circuit clerk may provide the required notice via the 10 registered electronic address. The circuit clerk shall 11 maintain a copy of the electronic content and a delivery 12 receipt as part of the records of his or her office. Electronic 13 14 notices shall have the same effect as a hard copy notice.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
