Makes appropriations to the Attorney General for FY11. Effective July 1, 2010.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 5

5 Section 5. The sum of \$1,300,000, or so much thereof as  
6 is available for use by the Attorney General, is appropriated  
7 to the Attorney General from the Illinois Gaming Law  
8 Enforcement Fund for State law enforcement purposes.

9 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
10 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the  
11 Asbestos Abatement Fund to the Attorney General to meet the  
12 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Environmental  
13 Enforcement-Asbestos Litigation Division:

4 Section 15. The amount of \$7,750,000, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney  
6 General Court Ordered and Voluntary Compliance Payment  
7 Projects Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for use,  
8 subject to pertinent court order or agreement, in the  
9 performance of any function pertaining to the exercise of the  
10 duties of the Attorney General, including State law  
11 enforcement and public education.

12 Section 20. The amount of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
14 Charity Bureau Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to  
15 enforce the provisions of the Solicitation for Charity Act  
16 and to gather and disseminate information about charitable  
17 trustees and organizations to the public.

18 Section 25. The amount of \$9,700,000, or so much thereof  
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney  
20 General Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the  
21 Office of the Attorney General for ordinary and contingent  
22 expenses, including State law enforcement purposes.

1           Section 30. The amount of \$900,000, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital  
3 Litigation Trust Fund to the Attorney General for financial  
4 support under the Capital Crimes Litigation Act.

5           Section 35. The amount of \$1,050,000, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tobacco  
7 Settlement Recovery Fund to the Attorney General for the  
8 funding of a unit responsible for oversight, enforcement, and  
9 implementation of the Master Settlement Agreement entered in  
10 the case of People of the State of Illinois v. Philip Morris,  
11 et al. (Circuit Court of Cook County, No. 96L13146), for  
12 enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act,  
13 and for handling remaining tobacco-related litigation.

14           Section 40. The amount of \$4,350,000, or so much thereof  
15 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney  
16 General's State Projects and Court Ordered Distribution Fund  
17 to the Attorney General for payment of interagency  
18 agreements, for court-ordered distributions to third parties,  
19 and, subject to pertinent court order, for performance of any  
20 function pertaining to the exercise of the duties of the  
21 Attorney General, including State law enforcement and public  
22 education.

1 Section 45. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as  
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General's  
 3 Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to be  
 4 expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon  
 5 which those funds were received.

6 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much  
 7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
 8 and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the  
 9 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses  
 10 of the Attorney General:

1 for expenses incurred in criminal prosecutions arising under  
2 the Statewide Grand Jury Act.

3 Section 75. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as  
4 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the  
5 Attorney General from the Married Families Domestic Violence  
6 Fund pursuant to Public Act 95-711 for grants to public or  
7 private nonprofit agencies for the purposes of facilitating  
8 or providing free domestic violence legal advocacy,  
9 assistance, or services to married or formerly married  
10 victims of domestic violence related to order of protection  
11 proceedings, or other proceedings for civil remedies for  
12 domestic violence.

13 ARTICLE 10

14 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
15 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
16 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
17 General Revenue Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to  
18 meet its ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year  
19 ending June 30, 2011:

- 22 for Bargaining Unit Employees .....8,829,600
- 23 For State Contributions to Social Security

1 for Bargaining Unit Employees .....675,500

2 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
4 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
5 General Revenue Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to  
6 meet its ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year  
7 ending June 30, 2011:

8 OPERATIONS

9 For Personal Services

10 for Non-Bargaining Unit Employees .....15,441,800

11 For State Contributions to Social Security

12 for Non-Bargaining Unit Employees .....1,181,300

13 Section 15. The amount of \$4,577,500, or so much thereof  
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
15 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to meet its  
16 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
17 2011.

18 Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated,  
19 the amount of \$1,887,500, or so much thereof as may be  
20 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to  
21 the Office of the Attorney General for operational expenses,  
22 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal



1 year ending June 30, 2011.

2 ARTICLE 99

3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
4 2010.
