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becomes necessary for the State or 2 Whenever it any governmental unit to furnish in a disaster area emergency 3 services directly related to or required by a disaster and 4 5 existing funds are insufficient to provide such services, the Governor may, when he considers such action in the best 6 interest of the State, release funds from the General Revenue 7 disaster relief appropriation in order to provide such 8 9 services or to reimburse local governmental bodies furnishing 10 such services. Such appropriation may be used for payment of the Illinois National Guard when called to active duty in 11 case of disaster, and for the emergency purchase or renting 12 of equipment and commodities. Such appropriation shall be 13 used for emergency services and relief to the disaster area 14 15 as a whole and shall not be used to provide private relief to 16 persons sustaining property damages or personal injury as a 17 result of a disaster.

Section 45. The sum of \$1,350,500, or so much thereof as 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 17 18 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency licensing facilities where radioactive uranium and 19 for 20 thorium mill tailings are generated or located, and related costs for regulating the decontamination and decommissioning 21 of such facilities and for identification, decontamination 22 environmental monitoring of unlicensed properties 23 and contaminated with such radioactive mill tailings. 24

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1 Section 50. The sum of \$320,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 3 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 4 for the purpose of funding costs related to environmental 5 cleanup of the Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under 6 cooperative agreements with the Federal Government.

The sum of \$145,500, or so much thereof as 7 Section 55. 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 9 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and 10 11 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available 12 13 surety.

14 Section 60. The sum of \$373,500, or so much thereof as 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 16 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 17 for local responder training, demonstrations, research, 18 studies and investigations under funding agreements with the 19 Federal Government.

20 Section 65. The sum of \$97,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety -15- OMB096 00370 KML 10371 b

1 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for related training and travel expenses 2 and to reimburse the Illinois State Police and the Illinois 3 Commerce Commission for costs incurred for activities related 4 to inspecting and escorting shipments of spent nuclear fuel, 5 6 hiah-level radioactive waste, and transuranic waste in Illinois as provided under the rules of the Agency. 7

8 Section 70. The sum of \$215,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield Agreed 10 Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for 11 the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and 12 insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site 13 near Sheffield, Illinois.

14 Section 75. The sum of \$585,000, or so much thereof as 15 be necessary, is appropriated from the Low-Level mav Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to 16 Illinois Emergency Management Agency for use 17 the in accordance with Section 14(a) of the Illinois Low-Level 18 19 Radioactive Waste Management Act for costs related to establishing a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility. 20

21 Section 85. The sum of \$180,000, or so much thereof as 22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation

Section 85. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 4 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency 6 Management Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for costs and expenses related to or in 7 support of a public safety shared services center. 8

9 Section 90. The sum of \$650,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 11 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency 12 Management Agency for costs and expenses related to or in 13 support of a public safety shared services center.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2010.
